From the Program Director -

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ! As we prepare to jump into another amazing summer full of Bible Study, Family Fun, Christian Community, and the Joy of Fellowship around God's Word I've had the opportunity to pause and reflect on the impact that Mount Carmel has had on so many. In addition to thanking God for all of the ways He has blessed campers I've taken some time to reflect on the ways that serving at Mount Carmel has profoundly changed my life and the lives of so many that I worked with as a counselor and now as the Program Director.

In the fall of 2019, I accepted the call of a lifetime to serve as the Program Director at Mount Carmel, I met the woman who would become my wife, and for the first time in my life, I started to consider whether God was calling me to go to seminary. None of those things would have been possible without people like you making it possible for me to serve you as a summer staffer at Mount Carmel.

In 2016 when my previous summer plans fell apart I remember dreading my arrival at Mount Carmel. When I moved into the infamous staff housing, "THE U", I vividly remember calling my parents in tears asking them to let me just go home. I thank God they didn't let me.

It was through my experiences as a counselor at Mount Carmel that my faith, long made dormant by the influences of peers, struggles in college, and the business of an achievement-based identity was re-awakened. It was at Mount Carmel that I heard the Word Proclaimed day after day and saw my peers living out their faith with integrity. It was through serving at Mount Carmel that my faith was renewed in a healthy way that opened doors and introduced me to my best friends who were by my side through thick and thin, united in Christian community. It was through serving at Mount Carmel that God made His presence known to me and sustained me when I traveled through the darkest chapters of my life. Without the opportunity to serve here, I would never have considered going into full-time ministry, but because of my time as a counselor, I heard God's call to ministry.

Of course, this hasn't been just my experience. Just to name a few staff alumni of the last few years who are now serving in full-time ministry or attending Bible College or seminary there is: Tim Knorek, Ben Sides, Kierra Blackstad, Blake Wright, Beth White, Emma Wollan, Luke Wollan, Sam Hoff, Gage Thalmann, Micah Johnson, Madi Johnson, Steven Wagner, Trevor Wersal, Courtney Corrente, and many more who left their summer experiences better equipped to serve in lay leadership in their home congregations. Each of these people had the opportunity to try on leadership, live out their faith, and proclaim the good news.

Whether it is through your presence and participation as family campers, through your prayers, or through your financial contributions none of us would have been able to be blessed like we were through serving you at Mount Carmel.

June 22-28 Forgivin' Livin'

Ground Up Grace Week: Guest Speaker: Matthew McCormick, Guest Preacher: Johan Hinderlie, Guest Musicians: Milt and Andrew Scott

The Rev. Dr. Matthew McCormick of Charleston, SC, will teach on living as God's absolved people using the Psalms. Johan and Sonja Hinderlie will be sharing stories of people from the Old Testament whose lives were shaped by the steadfast love of God.

Johan and Sonja Hinderlie were the directors of Mount Carmel for 28 years, from 1984 through 2012. In recent years, they've created a new ministry known as Ground Up Grace that shares daily podcasts and special versions of the Moravian Daily Texts. We are overjoyed to welcome them home to Mount Carmel this summer!

June 29 - July 5

Guest Speaker: Paul Cross, Guest Preacher: Frank Lanier, Guest Musicians: Milt and Andrew Scott

Paul Cross recently retired from serving as the lead pastor of Atonement Lutheran in Fargo, ND. Paul specializes in Inductive Bible Study, the same method of Bible study practiced by Mount Carmel's founders at the Lutheran Bible Institute. Join us for a week of wonderfully applied Biblical teaching including Paul Cross' token "Dad Jokes of the Day".

July 6-12 "Freedom of the Christian: A Layperson's Commentary on Galatians"

Guest Speaker: Ken Sundet Jones, Guest Preacher: Horacio Castillo

Ken Sundet Jones, Professor of Theology and Philosophy at Grand View University in Des Moines, Iowa, loves teaching undergrads. He was born in Heidelberg, which must be why he likes Luther so much. He was shaped by the Sturgis motorcycle rally in his hometown and by summers at his grandparents' cattle ranch. His doctoral dissertation covered 16th-century German evangelical funeral preaching. And he knows how to do knitting and Scandinavian flat-plane woodcarving.

July 13-19 "Bringing the Storyline of the Old and New Testaments to Life Before Your Eyes"

Guest Speaker: Paul Oman, Guest Preachers: Lon and Heidi Kvanli, Guest Musicians: Mike and Kristin Pierson

We welcome Paul Oman back to Mount Carmel for another experience of seeing God's Word come alive in painting. This week Paul is going to use a massive continuous canvas – five feet tall and twenty feet wide. We will visit the Patriarchs, the Kings, the Prophets, the Birth, Life and Death of Jesus, and the Easter Resurrection Stories. Day by day, you will be a witness to these events. Paul will teach as he paints, as a pastor and an artist. Music and recorded dramatic readings will accompany much of the painting process. Bring a Bible and be ready to dive in! You will have opportunities to participate, if you wish, but no artistic experience is necessary. Paul served as a teacher, and then as a Lutheran pastor when, in 2011, he took up work as an artistic pastor full-time. Paul works in many settings, including congregations, schools, universities, seminaries, camps, and prisons. His ministry is called Drawn to the Word. He lives near Amery, Wisconsin with his wife, Jana, and their children.

July 19-21 (2-Night) "The Foolish Cross"

Guest Speaker: Steve Olcott

Pastor Steve Olcott grew up in South Jersey and moved to Hutchinson, MN in 2003 to pursue ministry. A graduate of The Institute of Lutheran Theology, Steve is currently serving as a Pastor at Christ the King Lutheran Church in Hutchinson, MN. This weekend Steve will be teaching on the beautiful and unexpected ways that God meets us at our weakest points of life, humbling himself even to the point of crucifixion on the cross.

July 22-26 (4-Night) "Disciples of the Cross"

Guest Speaker: Steve King Guest, Preacher: Micah Johnson

The theme of discipleship has become quite popular in the Church in recent years, helping people understand what it means to be a follower of Christ. However, many discipleship materials on the market approach the topic with what Luther called a Theology of Glory, implying that by our works and personal disciplines we can turn ourselves into "Super-Christians" (better than mere church members). In this series, We will approach the topic in a different way, from the perspective of a biblical Theology of the Cross, focusing on Jesus' call to take up our cross and follow him. We will focus on some key themes that are not often addressed in many discipleship materials, including the centrality of the Word and Sacrament, an understanding of the Means of Grace, and a recognition of the Christian as both "Saint and Sinner." Pastor Steven King is the Managing Editor of Sola Publishing, in Graham, North Carolina. He also serves as the weekly preacher at Peace Lutheran Church in Gibsonville.

July 27–August 2 “Christ-Centered Apologetics”

Guest Speaker: Adam Francisco, Guest Preacher: Dave Gunnlaugson Guest Musician: Brian Spahr

The Scripture exhorts us to always be prepared to give a reason for the hope we have in Jesus Christ. This series covers a variety of topics—from the historicity of Jesus’ resurrection to the challenges posed by non-Christian worldviews like atheism and Islam—and lays the foundation for an apologetic witness to the truthfulness of the Christian faith. Adam Francisco is Director of Academics and a scholar in residence at 1517. He earned his DPhil from the University of Oxford and has two decades of experience teaching history, philosophy, and theology. He is the co-host of The Thinking Fellows podcast, author of a number of books, articles, and translations, and popular speaker on the topics of Christian apologetics, worldview, and the religion of Islam. He and his wife, Rachel, have four children, are care providers for foster children, and live in Wheaton, Illinois.

Tim has traveled internationally reciting the Gospel of Mark in both English and Norwegian and has recently memorized the book of Philippians. This retreat will teach you how to memorize, give you time to memorize, and inspire you in your memorization – bringing God’s Word into your heart. We will be focusing on Jesus our Good Shepherd, with John 10, Psalm 23, and other wonderful passages of Scripture. This is a first-time event for Mount Carmel. August 12–16 Adult Camp/Elderversity with Dr. Dan Van Voorhis, Johan Hinderlie, Tim and Patsy Baglien

Guest Teacher: Dr. Dan Van Voorhis, Guest Preacher: Johan Hinderlie, Guest Musicians: Tim and Patsy Baglien

Dr. Dan van Voorhis is the writer and host of The Christian History Almanac, a 1517 Podcast Network show. This 5–7 minute daily podcast is a reflection on the past events from that day that have shaped the church, stories of sinners and saints who have made up the church, as well as a piece of prose or poetry that reminds us that everything is going to be OK. Dr. van Voorhis speaks on a variety of topics in the history of the church, from the early beginnings through the 21st-century American evangelical church. Dan has spoken internationally on the impacts of the early church creeds, the Reformation, Christianity in the United States, and issues pertaining to the church and state in America. Dr. Dan van Voorhis, professor, speaker, and author presents around the nation on the topic of why young people are leaving the church.

September 22–25 Hymn Festival with Gracia Grindal

We welcome Gracia Grindal back to Mount Carmel for the Annual Hymn Festival. Come and enjoy singing the great hymns of the church. Learn about the hymn writers. Listen to the message of the hymns in a new way. Gracia joined the Luther Seminary faculty as associate professor of pastoral theology and ministry, communications in 1984. She was named professor of rhetoric in 1992. She came to the seminary from Luther College, Decorah, Iowa, where she was a member of the English department faculty from 1968 to 1984. Gracia has a long history of work in hymnody – writing hymns, translating hymns, editing hymnals, and serving on hymnal committees, She has had a special focus in working on the Scandinavian hymn tradition. She is a long-term friend of Mount Carmel.

September 27–29 Mount Carmel Women’s Retreat with Gretchen Ronnevik

Come enjoy the beautiful fall colors and the peace that Mount Carmel has to offer while being encouraged in your faith and experiencing fellowship with other women. Our guest speaker Gretchen Ronnevik loves rich theology rooted in real life. Her books include: *Ragged: Spiritual Disciplines for the Spiritually Exhausted*, and “The Story of Katie Luther: The Nun Who Escaped to Freedom”. She is married to a 4th generation farmer and has six kids who are now elementary through college age.

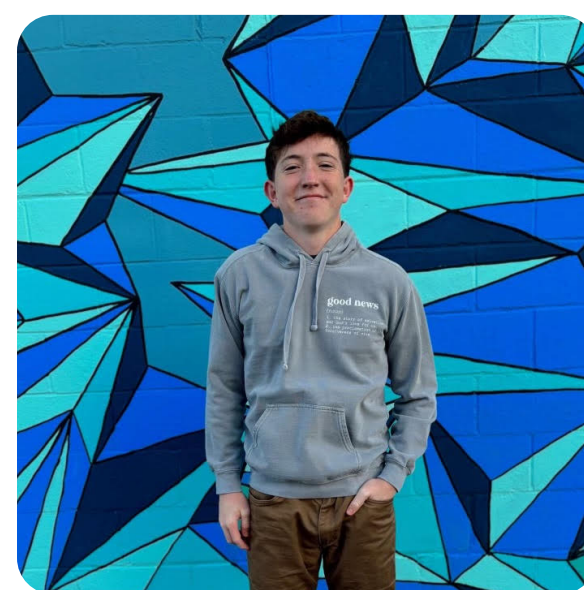

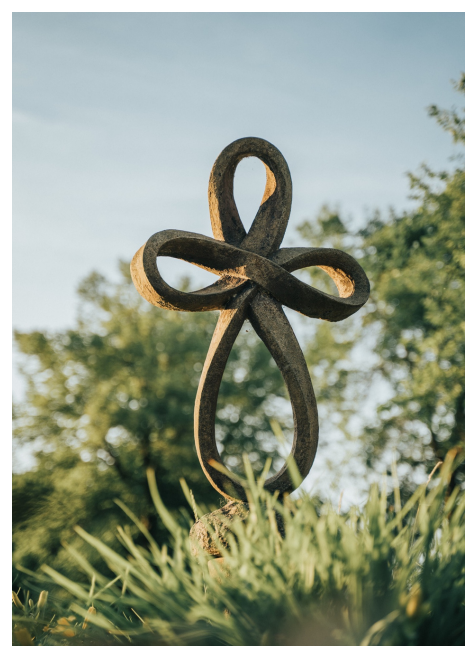
